SHIRAZ

Australia and more specifically South Australia has adopted Shiraz as our own. Therefore a notable portion of our wine list is dedicated to this wonderful variety.

So if big, rich and 'ballsey' is your preference then look no further than regions such as the Barossa Valley, McLaren Vale or the Hunter Valley NSW for significant richness, intensity and power to which there is no better partner than red meat.
